

Book Fund Grant in Memory of Mary Morgan

We are very excited to announce that LVBPT is the recipient of a Book Fund Grant from ProLiteracy! This means that starting this summer, we will be able to order a designated amount of teaching materials each year, free of charge from ProLiteracy.

Mary Cunningham Morgan was born in Bridgeport, CT and graduated from Harding High School in 1943. Throughout her life she supported and volunteered in programs that supported education, healthcare and the arts. In her honor and memory her family has established the Mary C. Morgan endowment at ProLiteracy, that will support the National Book Fund, a ProLiteracy program that makes grants for educational materials to adult literacy and adult basic education programs to help teach adults to read and further their education. Starting in 2019 the endowment has designated that annual distributions be made to support the work of ProLiteracy member program Literacy Volunteers of Greater Bridgeport.
